PLEASE ENSURE ITEMS YOU WISH TO SHARE ARE:

Safe, clean, and functional, no repairs needed and with all parts assembled/included.

- Kitchen items free of odors, rust, food residue, and damage/chips.
- Upholstered furniture and mattresses free of rips, stains, pet hair, and odors.
- Wood furniture stable and functional (minor cosmetic flaws okay).
- Appliances clean and in good working order.

NOT SURE IF YOU SHOULD DONATE AN ITEM?

Ask yourself: would you feel comfortable giving the item to a friend or family member? If yes, we'd love to connect!

ARRANGE A PICK-UP

We can pick-up furniture weekdays by appointment within a 15 mile radius of our resource center.
